

How Can I Use Art Walk?

The Art Walk Guide is to aid students in the development of sensory details within writing. There are many different ways to utilize this particular activity. The sky's the limit! Here are a few suggestions:

- During a literature study, have each student complete a gallery walk based off of how they feel, what they see during the chapter or at the completion of the novel.
- During a particular time in history, choose multiple paintings, songs, photos which symbolize the era and have students complete the Artwalk Activity.
- Set up multiple musical and visual aids around the room to evoke sensory response. Have students create a creative writing story based off of the details which they were introduced to during the Artwalk activity.
